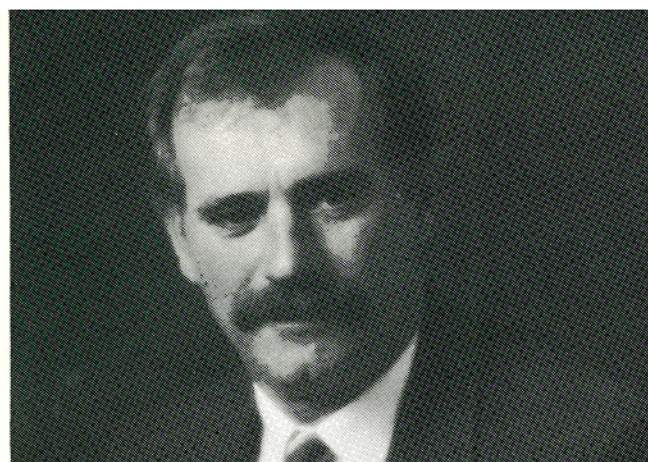

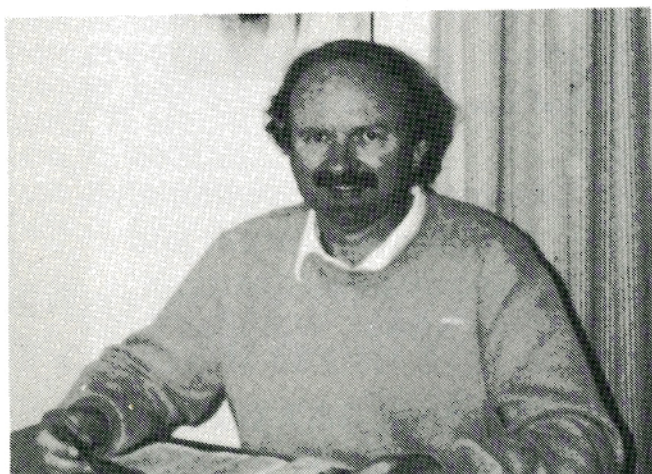
## Financial Position

Despite the Committee's strong promotion of the Club, there has been an undoubted decline in the number of boys wanting to play Junior Football in the East Fremantle area over the last six years.

As a consequence, this has had a marked effect on the revenue base of the Club. However, due to the efforts of parents and children in the early 80's and 70's the Club has a substantial investment which is now producing enough income to offset the shortfall in annual expenditure over revenue.

Also, as a result of having this nest egg, the Committee, in its promotional drive this year, was able to reduce fees by approximately 40% to make it possible for more children to play. I am pleased that 1991 has been the Club's best year in terms of boys playing since 1985.

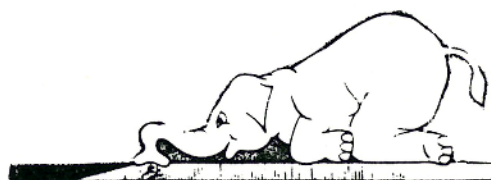

**DAVID WRIGHTSON** — A strong player who is improving each outing. Has a good defensive side to his game and spoils well.

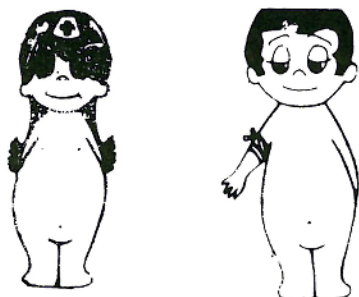

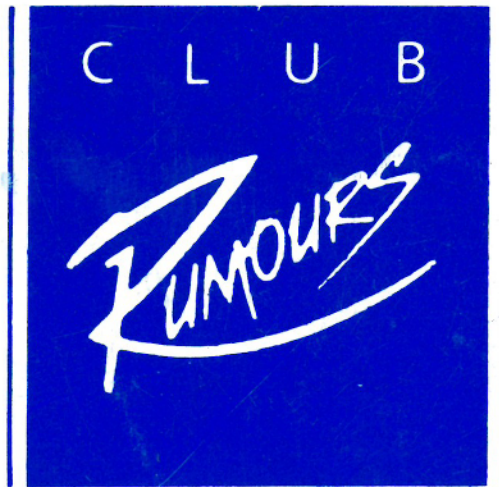
