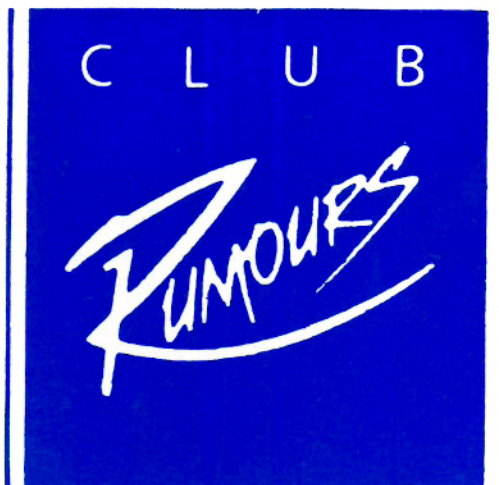

## Prologue

Members of the Committee of the East Fremantle Junior Football Club put in an enormous effort pre-season in an endeavour to increase the number of sides in our Club. It was seen as important to secure a 10's side this season for the future survival of the Club.

The recruitment drive consisted of:

- visiting local schools
- including information in school newsletters
- advertising in local newspapers.

However by far the biggest effort was put in by half a dozen members or so who personally delivered 7,000 pamphlets to letterboxes in our district from East Street in Fremantle through to Bicton.

The response was fantastic. The Club managed to field a freeball side for the first time in its history and unexpected sides were formed in the 10's and 11's with an additional side in the 12's. Overall, teams fielded grew from 4 in 1991 to 9 in 1992, including the freeball team.

It is hoped this injection of teams brings with it future coaches, future committee members and future league or AFL players. Primarily, however, it is hoped that all boys in our Club benefit personally through the various rewards any sport offers, but particularly team sports. I refer to mateship, character development, self discipline, confidence and even to a potential career at the highest level, for those who have the desire and commitment.

Arthur's service to the East Fremantle Junior Football Club was recognised in 1990 by the East Fremantle Town Council, who awarded him with their Citizen of the Year Award.

Whilst Arthur may be looking to quieter pastures, don't be surprised if you see him in future years waving the flags, serving in the canteen or even coaching. Such is the nature of the man.

# Junior Council Report

The East Fremantle Football Club Junior Council (Inc.) which administers the competition in the East Fremantle zone from 9's to 15's, has had another successful season.

The programme budget for this year amounted to \$30,000, of which \$17,000 in income came from Club team fees.

The balance of the major income of \$5,000 came from raffle tickets sold at East Fremantle League Oval prior to League home games. All Junior Football Clubs are allocated a home game whereby adult members from that particular Junior Club are required to sell tickets at both gates commencing from 10.30 a.m.

It was pleasing to see that our Club contributed \$800 through raffle sales this year, with minimum support from adults in our Club. Four adults attended and without the support of players from the 14's team, very few tickets would have been sold. It is hoped in future years the Club receives more support from parents of boys. Funds raised help offset team fees and ultimately the fees charged for boys to play.

On the expenditure side, the major costs were \$8,000 for ground charges to Local Government Councils and \$14,000 (approx.) for umpires' fees from 11's to 15's. The balance of expenditure covered miscellaneous items such as printing and stationery, drinks for Little League, State Schoolboys grant, combined side fees, coaches accreditation fees, etc.

The Junior Council Combined Sides were once again a success. The 15's won the State Championship. The 14's were runners-up, having been State Champions the previous year. The 13's were unlucky to miss the final, losing two matches by less than a goal.

If the success of the combined sides is a measure of the quality of football generally from players to coaches, then we should be pleased that our boys are exposed to a high standard throughout the season.

# Financial Overview for 1992

Whilst our Club has had a most successful season, with more boys than ever playing this year, we have not fared as well financially.

Over many years the Club has had an investment nest egg which had grown to over \$10,000 at its height. Interest of up to 15% from these funds has been a great help over the years.

In 1991 the Committee made a decision, a correct one in my opinion, to lower the fees considerably to attract more boys. We had a modest increase in numbers in 1991 but not enough to offset the lower fee income. This meant a trading loss of about \$1,650 last year. Interest on investment reduced our nett position over the year to a loss of \$460.

In 1992 there was a modest increase in fees and a huge increase in boys resulting in a threefold increase in fee income. Other major sources of income were the canteen profit \$1,821 and the quiz night \$1,087.

However, on the expenditure side there have been significant increases in costs, simply due to the increase in numbers. Also the Club has now taken on a players' insurance scheme costing \$800. We have also had to draw down our investment capital by \$2,000. Lower capital and low interest rates are having a marked effect on our ability to maintain our asset level.

Whilst many bills are not in yet, my assessment of the situation is that we will have a trading loss over the year in the range of \$2,000 offset by interest on investment of \$800.

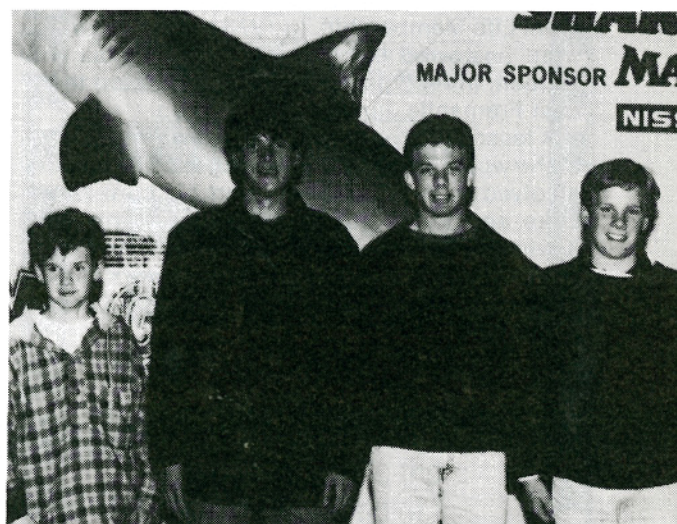

# The Reg Byers/Ron Jones Era 1975-1977

An important era of the Club's history began in 1975 when Reg Byers became President and Ron Jones was elected as his Secretary. It was no coincidence that the next three years were very successful for our Club, both on and off the field.

Reg and Ron made a great team. Reg played the smooth, charismatic President who made everyone feel welcome when they were at the Football Club. Ron was an efficient, hard-working Secretary who was meticulous with details and the running of the Club.

On the field the Club won four Premierships during this period. In 1975, the 18's were coached by Graeme Verco. In 1976 the 16's were undefeated, coached by Merton Davies. In 1977 the 16's were coached by Merton Davies and in 1977 the 14's White were coached by Carl Micale.

Besides Premierships, the Club was very competitive in many other grades and we were the envy of the other clubs in the Junior Council at this time.

In the off-field stakes, Reg and Ron, together with their hard-working committee of the time, made the Club an enjoyable place for parents to become involved. Many social dances, trips to Augusta, successful wind-ups and other off-field antics increased the parent participation within the Club.

In 1976 the Club recognised the work of Reg Byers, together with his wife Judy, and awarded them Life Membership. In 1978 the same awards were bestowed upon Ron Jones and his wife Doreen, in recognition of their dedication to the East Fremantle Junior Football Club.

A lesson can be learnt by us all when you look at the work of Reg and Ron. Reg initially became involved in the Club to support his sons Steve, Luke and Tony and Ron likewise to his sons Kevin and Wayne. The facts are that many other boys benefited from their dedicated work and the Club enjoyed one of the most successful eras in its history.

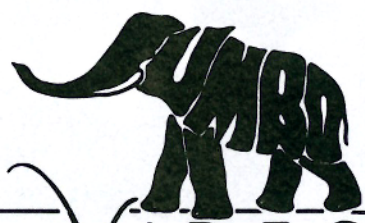

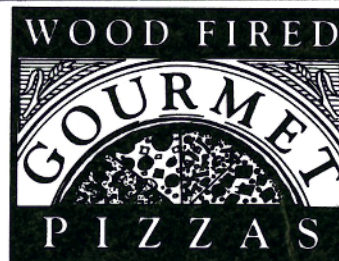

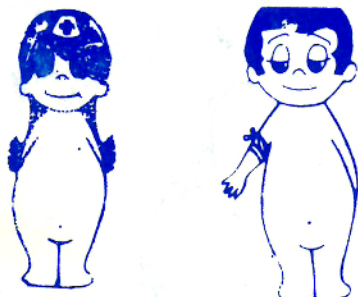
